Who is Working on Fire?

The WOF Programme was launched in September 2003. It provides poverty and income relief to young unemployed South Africans through the creation of work opportunities, while supplying integrated fire management to Government, local municipalities, communities, environmental agencies, Fire Protection Associations (FPAs); etc. Today, the programme employs more than 5,000 young wildland firefighters, stationed in more than 200 teams throughout the major fire prone areas in South Africa.
